Youth United Grant Criteria

Eligible grant applications will include community-focused volunteer projects that are:

- focused within the city of Winnipeg and neighbouring communities
- youth led organized, planned and executed by youth
- contributing to positive social change by responding to one of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals commissioned by the United Nations, listed on page four of this application form

Youth applying for a grant must be a member of a Youth United Chapter and associated with a sponsoring organization (a school or nonprofit community agency).

If you are applying for a repeat project (one that we've sponsored in the past), we will ask you to demonstrate how you have learned from your experience and how that learning has influenced this year's project planning.

Non-eligible grant applications include but are not limited to:

• fundraising projects or any public event that will raise money for another organization, person or group

Note: no more than 30% of requested funds may be applied towards honorariums for speakers.



What is the review process?

Once Youth United volunteers have received an application, they will assess it carefully to ensure it fits the criteria. Youth United will then contact your project team leader to address any questions and confirm your attendance at the closest application review date. If you do not hear from us, please email Youth United at youthunited@unitedwaywinnipeg.ca to ensure your application has been received.

How are funds disbursed?

If your project is funded, funds will be disbursed through the school or community organization your group is connected with. You will be required to complete a detailed project report and submit copies of your receipt(s) no later than one month after the completion of your project. Any unused funds must be returned to United Way Winnipeq.

Do I need to acknowledge United Way Winnipeg?

Yes. We ask that you acknowledge our support in any way you are able (e.g., putting our logo on your promotional materials). Please contact us for our logo.

Do I need to report on progress?

Yes. We will ask you to keep us up to date on your project plans. Once your project has been completed, you will be required to complete a project report and submit copies of your receipt(s) no later than one month after the completion of your project.
